

AFCI Privacy Policy

We at the Association For Creative Industries (AFCI) value every aspect of our relationship with you, and nothing can be more important than maintaining your trust and confidence. We take our responsibility to protect take your privacy very seriously. The purpose of this notice is to make you aware of our policies and procedures for collection, disclosing and safeguarding your information.

What information do we collect?

We collect personally identifiable information from you when you register on our site or place an order.

When ordering or registering on our site, you may be asked to enter your name, e-mail address, mailing address, phone number, credit card information, or other personally identifiable information. We retain this information in our records. You may, however, visit our site anonymously.

What do we use your information for?

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

How do we protect your information?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personally identifiable information when you place an order or enter, submit, or access your personally identifiable information.

We offer the use of a secure server. All supplied financial/credit information (including social security number) is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and then encrypted into our Payment gateway providers database only to be accessible by those authorized with special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential.

After a transaction, your financial information (credit cards, social security numbers, financials, etc.) will not be stored on our servers, though we will keep records of your names, address.

Do we use cookies?

Yes. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the sites or service providers' systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information

We use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. However, trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you, may have access to your information as part of the service process, but we require those parties to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect our or others' rights, property, or safety.

Non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.
